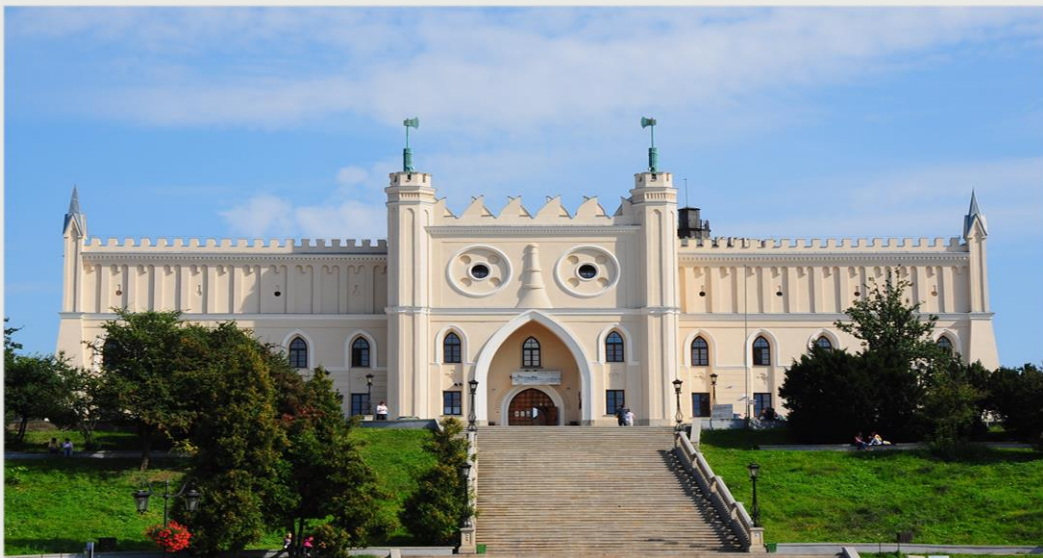

Aim of the workshop

Calibration is one of the fundamental parts of quality assessment in education. It helps both teachers and students in the interpretation of certain criteria in similar ways.

Calibration in dentistry education also helps in preparing undergraduate students for practice including expected knowledge and skills and without causing unnecessary stress and doubts. This result is achieved mostly by comparison, discussion and agreements on interpretation.

The aim of the calibration workshop is to extend knowledge about objective assessment. This workshop will be a theoretical and practical introduction to the worldwide methods of teaching and coaching in the dentistry curriculum.
